WHEN TO USE THIS TOOL:

- This tool measures student enjoyment at school.
- This tool can be used based on student need and how often the teacher wants to collect the data (weekly, monthly, per quarter).

HOW TO USE THIS TOOL:

Before using the tool

- Determine how often the survey will be given to the students and when you want to students to take the survey.
- Model and teach the new vocabulary to the students at least for the first few times.
- Give them the purpose behind the survey.

While using the tool

- Give the students time and space to answer the survey.
- You may help students clarify the language on the survey (if necessary).

After using the tool

- Reflect on what the students are saying about their needs and being happy at school.
- Meet with students individually to confer about their survey. This will not only help to understand their needs, but also help build trusting relationships with them.
